1. **Review your financial aid packages.** Read carefully for loan amounts, etc. Bring your info to the counselors if you need help understanding it. Don't be afraid to contact a school you really want to attend and tell them that the offer isn't enough. Explain the tuition your family pays for private education and any other unusual circumstances.
2. **Make a decision BEFORE May 1<sup>st</sup>**—The day by which you should commit to a school is typically May 1<sup>st</sup>. Inform the school you plan to attend and submit necessary housing forms ASAP or you may be out of luck if housing is limited. Also respond to any other schools where you were accepted and inform them of your decision to attend elsewhere.
3. **Complete your Senior Closing Task Survey**—this is essential for the mailing of your final high school transcript to your school of choice and for the senior assembly. Be prepared to support in writing any acceptances granted or scholarships offered. Complete this on Family Connection on or before April 16<sup>th</sup>!!!
4. **Enjoy Prom, Senior Skip Day, Grandparents Day, Senior Assembly, Baccalaureate, and Graduation.** These are once in a lifetime events. **Make them positive and fun!!**
5. **Keep in touch with the Counseling Center.** Come back and tell us how school and life are going for you!!!
